### Job Description

The Research Assistant (RA) will work for Dr. Alison Godwin, Researcher at the Centre for Research in Occupational Safety and Health (CROSH) at Laurentian University in Sudbury ON ([www.crosh.ca](http://www.crosh.ca)). The RA will be responsible for both lab and field data collection related to a Ministry of Labour grant in the area of health and safety. They will coordinate survey development, pilot testing of survey, administering survey through field work and mail out, and data collection of eyetracker, HRV and EEG measures in the field. Some travel to Southern and Northern Ontario partners for data collection will be required. Training in line-of-sight methods will be provided as part of the basic training to facilitate completion of research contracts in visibility studies.

### Qualifications

Applications should have a Bachelor's and Master's degree in Human Kinetics, Mechanical Engineering, Health Sciences or other, related degree. Experience in Occupational Safety and Health considered an asset. Applicants should have experience working with researchers and graduate students. Applicants should have excellent written and oral presentation skills in English. The ability to communicate in French is an asset. Previous work experience and supervision of undergraduate or graduate students is also an asset.
