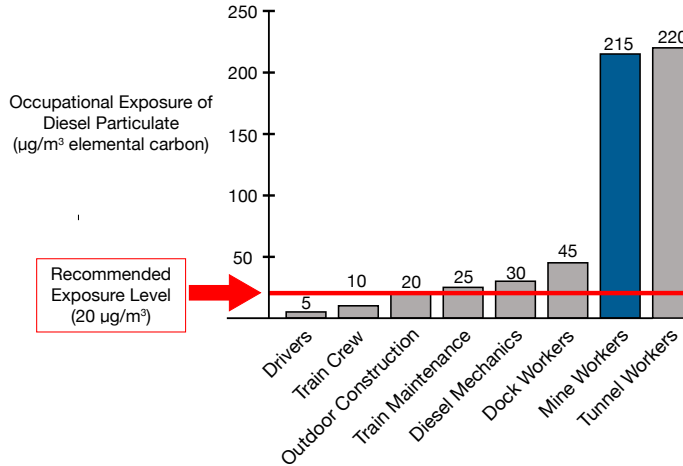
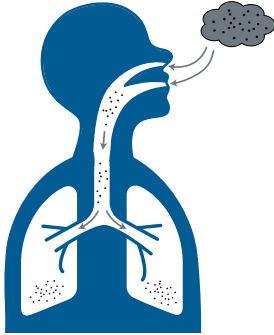


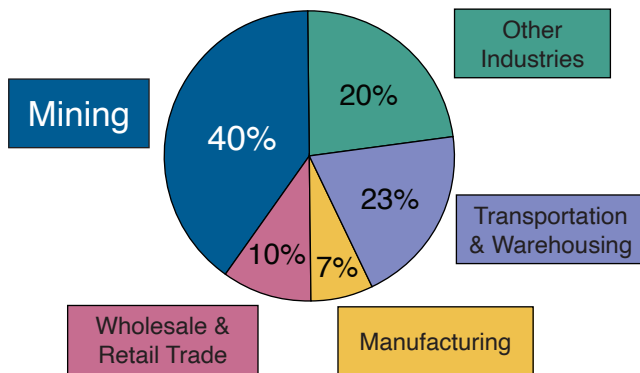
You are being overexposed to harmful diesel particulates.
