

## CROSH Travel Scholarship Criteria

**Value:** \$500 maximum (non-renewable)

**Application Due:** Anytime

**Eligibility:**

- CROSH student member or Postdoctoral Fellow
- Full-time university student

**Criteria:**

- Proposed conference presentation is focused on a topic related to Occupational Health and Safety
- The student must submit either a written application to CROSH (no more than 250 words) indicating how the proposed conference topic relates to the vision/mission/mandate of CROSH or attach the submitted Abstract; assuming abstract justifies for why his/her proposed topic is relevant and beneficial to CROSH and the skills he/she will learn as a researcher.
- The student must attach evidence that their proposed topic has been accepted for either an oral or poster presentation.
- Upon Submission of receipts for reimbursement; the applicant must attach information about the conference, when they return: ideally a photo of the student presenting and a short outline of why the conference was valuable to them. This information will be used by CROSH to: i) share with the funding Donor; ii) used to recruit future travel award funds; and iii) used for reporting purposed to the Ministry of Labour, Immigration, Training, and Skills Development.
